State of Ohio BWC protocol for FY 21/22

- BWC sponsored sessions will be internet based. No in person sessions.
- Rebates are again suspended for this FY therefore many reporting requirements like biannual reports are also suspended. The plan is to resume the Safety Council rebates in the future.
- Drug-Free Safety Program, DFSP, offers a premium rebate (4% basic/7% advanced level) to eligible employers for implementing a loss-prevention strategy addressing workplace use and misuse of alcohol and other drugs, especially illegal drugs. Required annual employee and supervisor training, plan, reports, drug testing, EAP.
- Industry-Specific Safety Program, ISP, focus on hazards that affect your specific industry. Improve workplace safety and get a premium rebate by using BWC training and consulting service and/or attending the Ohio Safety Congress & Expo.
- Safety Grants cover costs to: purchase equipment to substantially reduce or eliminate injuries and illnesses associated with a particular task or operation; implement the DFSP; start a workplace wellness program to improve the overall health and well-being of your workers.
- Policy Activity Rebate, PAR, employers choose from 33 activities to earn a 50% policy rebate up to \$2,000. Complete 11 credits during the enrolled policy year (by 5/31 for private employers and by 11/30 for public employers).
- Experience Modifier Limit, EM Cap, limits increase in premiums. ISP, Industry Specific Program, training required.
- Lapse-free rebate, receive a 1-percent premium rebate, up to \$2,000 each policy year, by paying premiums on time and not having a lapse in coverage during the past 60 months.

SASC protocol for FY 21/22. Will:

- Maintain SASC Planning Committee oversight of programs.
- Have restaurant drawings in August, September, November, December, January, February, March, May and June.
- Offer two grand prizes of \$250 each to be awarded at the end of FY 2021/2022. Your company earns one chance each time someone attends a monthly program. Can be used for safety training, recognition, supplies, or equipment.
- Hold two in-person bonus events (health requirements permitting). These are not part of the BWC schedule.
- Have monthly internet-based presentations, usually on the third Friday of the month at noon.
- Promote bring your own lunch watch parties for small groups (health requirements permitting). Locations will rotate and include: Salem Area Chamber, Butech, Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Quaker Manufacturing, BOC, and City of Salem. If you want to attend at one of that month's host sites, you need to let us know when you register.
- Offer additional safety training based on member interest.
- Participate in community events like Quakerfest and parades.
